



**CATCA CAW 5454 & NAV CANADA
Workplace Childcare Feasibility Study
Communication 10-01**

On February 8, 2010, the working group investigating the feasibility of childcare for CATCA members working at NAV CANADA formally launched the needs assessment survey at the two selected pilot sites. The Winnipeg and Vancouver members of the working group have overseen the communication and distribution of a survey to all CATCA members working in the pilot ACCs. The survey is comprehensive to understanding current childcare needs and arrangements as well as looking at what might be the desired type of care in the near term (i.e., looking out 2-5 years). Results are due by March 8th.

The needs assessment is one component of the study which will also address such topics including but not limited to:

- Provincial and municipal requirements/regulations respecting childcare in the workplace
- Services in the area
- Construction requirements / implications for the ACC
- Risk and Insurance requirements and implications for NAV CANADA

Following the analysis of all the research / survey data, the members of the working group will be putting forward to the Joint Steering Committee its report of findings. This activity is expected to be completed sometime in the spring of 2010. Decisions respecting further activity beyond the findings report will be made at the Steering Committee level.
